

SOTH Children's & Youth Ministry COVID-19 Wellness Policy

Sunday School will be offered in-person with social distancing and face masks for students, ages 5 and up AND via video lessons/material emailed to parents for at home use.

Confirmation will be offered in-person with social distancing and face masks AND via live stream through YouTube and Zoom for at home participation.

IMPACT will have combination weekly small group social check-in via ZOOM AND in-person Sunday night gatherings with social distancing and face masks.

- Classroom tables, chairs, door handles, light switches, TV remotes and any other major contact surface will be sanitized before class time.
- We will check each teacher, leader, and classroom helper's temperature with an infrared temperature gun upon arrival for Sunday School, Confirmation or IMPACT.
- We will ask parents to check their child's temperature to make sure they don't have a fever before taking them to Sunday School, Confirmation or IMPACT.
- Anyone with a fever or anyone who has had a fever in the past 24 hours will not be allowed to attend.
- Anyone who has been ill within the past 14 days or is living with someone who has been ill in the past 14 days will not be allowed to attend.
- Anyone who has tested positive for COVID or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID in the past 14 days will not be allowed to attend.
- Each student, teacher, leader, and classroom helper will use hand sanitizer when they arrive and exit their classroom/meeting space.
- All teachers, leaders, classroom helpers and students will need to wear a face mask during in-person, indoor class/activities.
- Students will sit/participate socially distanced in their classroom or other meeting space. No more than 2 students per 6-foot table.
- Students will bring a zip-lock bag with their name on it with their own school supplies...pencils, crayons, markers or colored pencils and a few glue sticks that will remain in the classroom for them to use each time they are at class. (Classroom scissors will be sanitized before and after use the few times they are used).
- Older Sunday School students will be assigned a classroom Bible to use for the entire school year and label it with a post-it with their name on it. This Bible will stay in the classroom.
- Snacks will not be served in any classrooms this year.
- Teachers & classroom helpers will sanitize tables, chairs, door handles, light switches, TV remotes and any other major contact surface before they leave the room.
